
Minutes of ICT-16 Business Meeting

1) Approval of Minutes of Last Business Meeting

2) ICT Committee Reports

Website Committee (K. Nöckler)

Miroslaw Rozycky, Poland continues to lead the standing Website Committee, and has done an excellent job of maintaining the ICT website, currently hosted by GoDaddyTM. Unfortunately, Mirek was unable to attend ICT-16. There was discussion during the Executive Committee meetings recommending that an additional member of the website committee have full administrator rights for managing the ICT website to ensure capacity and continuity.

The link on the ICT website to the *Trichinella* database (managed by the International *Trichinella* Reference Center, Unit of Foodborne and Neglected Parasitic Diseases, Department of Infectious Diseases Istituto Superiore di Sanità) is now fully functional.

There is an ongoing need for members to update the ICT website with new information about *Trichinella*, including human and animal outbreaks. This could include links to other sources of these data as applicable.

6) Proceedings for ICT-16 (K. Nöckler)

As for previous ICT conferences, a selection of best papers (oral or poster presentation) will be published in a Special Issue of Veterinary Parasitology guest-edited by selected ICT members. Only papers presented at ICT-16 can be published. Manuscripts need to be submitted for peer review according to VetPar guidelines for authors. Further information on formatting of manuscripts, deadline for submission, etc., will be provided in due course.

7) Bid for the 17th International Conference on Trichinellosis in 2027 (K. Nöckler)

A declaration of interest (http://www.trichinellosis.org/uploads/ICT-17%20-%201-%20Declaration%20of%20interest.pdf) to host the ICT-17 in 2027 should be send by e-mail to the ICT President by December 31st, 2023. The ICT President will disseminate the declarations of interest to the members of the Executive Committee who will decide by electronic vote on the candidates for hosting ICT-17. Selected candidates will be notified accordingly by January 30th, 2024 and will then be asked to prepare and submit more comprehensive proposals as stipulated in the *ICT Policies and Procedures* by April 30th 2024.

As described in the *ICT By-Laws*, individuals who have distinguished themselves in the field of *Trichinella* and trichinellosis may be elected to Honorary Membership. <u>Recognition of Dr. Ruben Binaghi</u> (Brad Scandrett)

The ICT acknowledged the contributions of one of its past members, Dr. Ruben Binaghi, who passed away in 2022.

Dr. Binaghi obtained his PhD in 1946 from the University of Buenos Aires and was an immunologist who worked extensively with *Trichinella* as a model. He became a member of ICT in 1985. He held various posts throughout his career, including in France and Italy, and collaborated on many *Trichinella* research studies with Fabrizio Bruschi and Stella Maris Venturiella.
